Please briefly present the partner organization.	Hakkari University is a public higher education institution located in the eastern region of Turkey. The university conducts its educational and research activities under 7 faculties, 1 graduate school, 3 vocational schools, and 1 school of foreign languages. Additionally, 12 research and application centers operate within the university, contributing to regional and international scientific studies and enriching the academic community. The university's academic staff consists of 341 members, while the administrative staff number 415. Currently, 5,113 students are enrolled in associate, undergraduate, and graduate programs.

	<p>Hakkari University adopts a quality-oriented approach to higher education and has been accredited for two years by the Turkish Higher Education Quality Council (YÖKAK). This accreditation certifies the university's adherence to high standards in education, research, and governance, as well as its commitment to continuous development.</p> <p>The university actively participates in international exchange and cooperation programs, particularly under Erasmus+ KA1 (KA131, KA171, and Erasmus+ Youth Exchanges) and KA2 projects, strengthening academic and cultural ties with partner institutions worldwide. The Erasmus Office is responsible for coordinating these mobility activities, facilitating international collaborations, and promoting intercultural learning opportunities. The university also supports inclusion and diversity through specialized projects, such as those focusing on disadvantaged students and regional development.</p> <p>By engaging in strategic partnerships and research collaborations, Hakkari University aims to contribute to global academic networks and provide its students and staff with international mobility and learning opportunities.</p>
